

# Goose Hunt at Pro Outfitters



Pro Outfitters offers fully guided spring snow goose hunts in Northwest Missouri and Southwest Missouri. We start hunting around Feb.15th and hunt thru March 15th.

Locations of our hunts are determined by the staging locations of the masses of snow geese. We follow the migration as they make there way thru the state of Missouri. Many of our Northwest Missouri hunts take place around the famous Squaw Creek Refuge.

## Equipment

Each snow goose hunt consists of hunting over 1,000 to 2,000 full bodies, sillosocks, windsocks, and shells. We hunt a maximum of 8 hunters per field. We hunt out of pits, layout blinds, and haybale blinds. We try to have our decoy spreads setup before you arrive, but depending on our need to move on the geese, you should expect to help pickup and move or reset the spread. This is done for your benefit to help maximize our time in the field and insure you have a productive hunt.

## Missouri

### Fully Guided 1/2 day Duck Hunt – \$150 per person

Hunt includes morning hunt till noon, personal guide, and transportation to and from the hunting location.

### Fully Guided Morning and Afternoon Hunt – \$200 per person

Hunt includes morning hunt till 11 am and afternoon hunt starting at 2 p.m. Included in the hunt is an experienced guide and transportation to and from the blind.

### Full Day Guided Hunt with Lodging and Meals – \$250 per person

The hunt includes previous nights lodging, breakfast, a morning hunt till 11 am, lunch, and afternoon hunt stating at 2 p.m. Included in the hunt is an experienced guide and transportation to and from the blind.

### 3 Day Hunting Package – \$750 per person

The package includes 3 full days of hunting and 3 nights of lodging with 3 meals a day. Included in the hunt is an experienced guide and transportation to and from the blind.

### 5 Day Hunting Package – \$1,250 per person

The package includes 5 full days of hunting and 5 nights of lodging with 3 meals a day. Included in the hunt is an experienced guide and transportation to and from the blind.

#### Deposit

Within 10 days of booking your hunt, 50% of your total hunt is required to hold your dates. The remaining 50% is due upon arrival at the lodge. This is non-refundable, but if you cannot make it due to unavoidable circumstances, the deposit can be put towards a future hunt.

Deposits are non transferable.

If a hunter cannot make the trip it is acceptable to replace them with someone else, as long as the party size remains the same. If you can't make the hunt and can't find a replacement, you forfeit your deposit.

## **Check it twice; this list could help make your goose hunt a success**

- rubber boot, hip boots or chest waders
- wool socks
- Missouri nonresident small game hunting license (available online or over the counter)
- Missouri migratory bird hunting license (available online or over the counter)
- hunters education certificate (Required of those born on or after Jan. 1, 1967)
- shotgun
- steel shotgun shells (T's or BB's)
- camouflaged clothing
- camouflaged face mask, or stocking hat face mask
- warm camouflage hat with ear protection
- gloves
- long underwear
- hand heat packs
- raingear
- camera
- cooler for meat transport
